To install Downloader on your NVIDIA Shield TV, follow these steps:

1. Enable "Unknown Sources" (Allow installation from third-party apps):

- Go to Settings on your NVIDIA Shield.
- Select Security & Restrictions under the "Device Preferences" section.
- Turn on the option for Install unknown apps.
